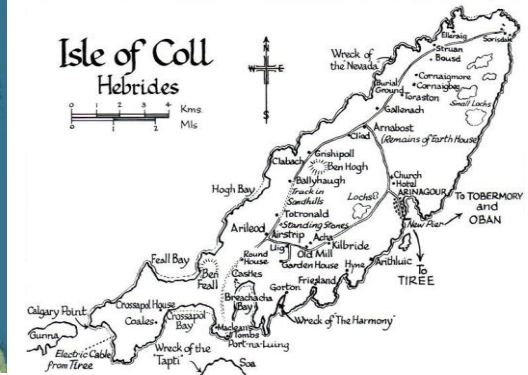


An Island Home: Where would we prefer to live?

Human feature	Something that is man-made and built by humans, e.g. city, town, village, factory, farm, house	Physical feature	Naturally created features of the Earth, e.g. mountain, hill, river, lake, soil, vegetation, season, climate, weather

Island	An island is an area of land that is surrounded by water
Archipelago	A group of islands is called an archipelago
Coast	The area where the sea and land meet is called a coast
Coastline	A line that forms the boundary between the land and the sea
Border	A line on a map which separates two countries
Grid reference	A grid reference is a method for the location of a point on a map
Atlas	A book of maps
Compare	Comparing is looking at what is the same between two or more things to find similarities
Contrast	Contrasting is looking at what is different between two or more things to find differences
Climate	Climate is the temperature, wind, humidity, snow, and rain in a place over the course of years. Climate is like the weather , but over a long time
Wildlife	Wildlife is a general term for all wild , untamed animals. An example of wildlife is a deer or fox
Vegetation	Vegetation refers to the plants and trees growing in a region
