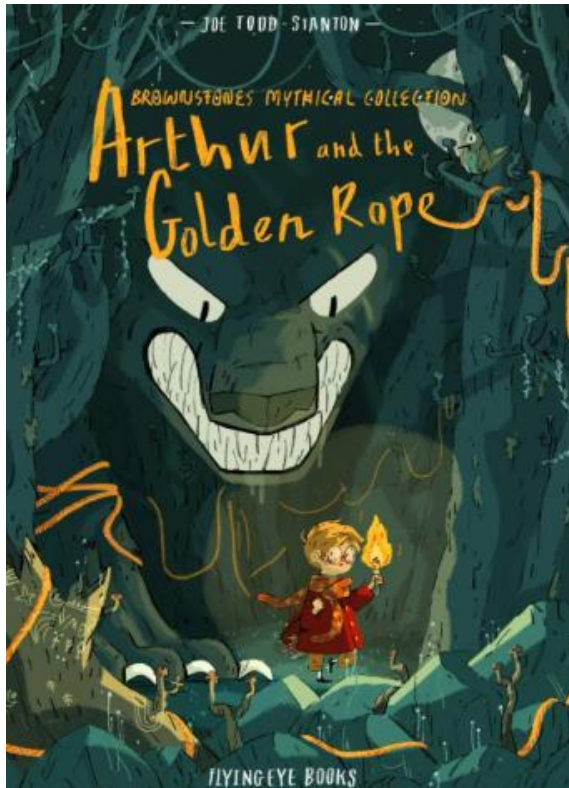




Arthur and the Golden Rope by Joe Todd-Stanton
