


# Animals, including humans: offspring

<p><b>Glossary</b></p> <p><b>grow</b> – to become bigger</p> <p><b>germinate</b> – when a seed forms a small root and/or shoot</p> <p><b>produce</b> – to make</p> <p><b>reproduce</b> – to make more animals and plants; animals and plants produce offspring</p> <p><b>seed</b> – the part of a plant that will grow into a new plant and/or shoot</p>	<p>Can you name these <b>animals</b> and <b>plants</b>?</p> 	<p>Animals and plants make more of themselves by <b>reproducing</b>. Examples</p>  <p>Humans give birth to <b>babies</b> → babies grow into <b>children</b> → children grow into <b>adult humans</b></p>  <p>Chickens lay <b>eggs</b> → the eggs hatch into <b>chicks</b> → the chicks grow into <b>chickens</b></p> 	 <p>Plants and animals live <b>everywhere</b> on our planet.</p> <p>Use some of these words to describe where different plants and animals live –</p> <p><b>in, on, under, beneath, within, next to, beside, inside, over, above,</b></p>	<p>Plants produce <b>seeds</b> → seeds germinate into <b>seedlings</b> → seedlings grow into <b>plants</b></p>
