Dear Parents and Carers,

With the school summer holidays in full swing and a new academic year approaching, we wanted to contact you with information regarding your child(ren)'s return to school.

Timing of school day

In March, The Schools' White Paper sets out that schools will offer a minimum school week of 32.5 hours by September 2023. This equates to 6.5 hours per day. Therefore, we are revising the timings of the school day as follows:

Gates open:	08:30am
School day starts:	08:40am
Gates close:	08:50am
School day ends:	Reception and KS1: 3:25pm
	KS2: 3:20pm
Gates close:	3:35pm

Attendance

The DFE have recently published a document titled 'Working together to improve school attendance and punctuality' with the aim of reducing the number of unauthorised absences and late marks recorded in schools. We are expecting further guidance from the Local Authority in September, but wanted to inform you now that, as a school, we may be required to enforce more stringent processes and action in response to unauthorised absences, including lateness. We felt that this information was especially important given our earlier start times from 7th September, as outlined above.

Uniform

The summer holidays tend to bring with them the annual trip to buy school uniform, so with that in mind, we wanted to remind you of the expectations around school uniform. Our updated uniform policy can be found here:

- All pupils must wear full uniform. If parents have difficulty in providing their child with uniform, please see a member of staff for support.
- It is essential that all uniform and other belongings are clearly labelled with your child's full name and class.
- Long hair should be tied up for school and must be tied back for PE and practical activities.
- On PE days, your child can wear their PE kit to school. PE days for each class will be communicated in September.
- Their PE kit must be in the school colours, as outlined on the uniform policy:
 - ✓ White t-shirt
 - ✓ Green or black shorts
 - ✓ Black, green or grey jogging bottoms
 - Trainers may be worn for outdoor PE but children will need a pair of black plimsolls/pumps for indoor PE. These need to be sent into school in a suitable named bag to be kept on your child's peg.
 - ✓ Clive Marks are also selling BVP fleeces that parents may wish to purchase for PE days.
- Although a digital or analogue watch can be worn to school, please do not allow your child to wear a smart device on school days.

Other equipment

All stationery and equipment is provided by school and children take responsibility for their own stationery pack. Therefore, there is no need to send your child in with a pencil case.

All children were given a BVP water bottle for use in the classroom, when they started with us. If you need to purchase a new water bottle, please contact the school office.

You can purchase a BVP school bag (via ParentPay) which is large enough to store the items your child needs to bring into school. If you purchase an alternative bag for your child, then we do ask that you restrict the size of your child's school bag due to limited space in our cloakrooms.

On Wednesday 7th September, we will be holding a 'Meet the Teacher' event from 3:30-4:00pm. Teachers will bring the children out at the end of the day and you will be invited back
