

This week's learning in English was linked to last week's National Poetry Day. Children from Reception all the way

through to Y6 have been looking at a beautiful book called 'The Lost Words' by Robert MacFarlane and Jackie Morris. The Lost Words is a book of 'spells'-they are called spells rather than poems because they are designed to be spoken (or sung!) out loud. Why? Because these are the words which were removed from a



children's dictionary, on the grounds that they were not being used enough by children to merit inclusion.

This week, the school buildings have been brimming with all sorts of learning linked to The Lost Words, including artwork and poetry writing. Teachers are also busy displaying your children's work ready for you to enjoy on Parents' Evening after half term- we can't wait for you to see it!

Passwords

If another adult is collecting your child, please ensure that they have your password. This informs school that you have given your permission for your child to be released to another person. It also eliminates the need to email school, as teachers do not access their emails during the school day.

School Photos

School photos will be taken on Thursday 20th and Friday 21st November. Children should wear their full school uniform so please do not send your child in their PE kit on these days.

Y6 Walk Home Alone Permission

If your Y6 child does not currently walk home unaccompanied but you would like them too next term, please complete the online form by following this link <u>Y6 walk home alone permission</u> indicating the arrangements for your child.

The deadline for your response is Sunday 30th October 2022. Your child will not be allowed to leave school unaccompanied at the end of the day without a completed form.

We ask that you discuss with your Y6 child what they should do at the end of the school day if they are worried, or unsure of what to do. School advises that they return to their class teacher or the school office to tell an adult in these circumstances and we will contact you.

If arrangements for your child change during the school year, you must submit an amended online form via the link. 
