# Comments/Suggestions made:

Not seeing menu is detached – display in the app or connect to website.

Balance reminders would be helpful separate from the app.

Happy with the selections – desserts what about sugar content?

Pro veg menu – introduced post Easter

Want to see the salad station – photographs would be good.

See visuals from school council to encourage packed lunches to switch over – visual menu to be handed around.

2.40 seems good value – parents would be open to slight increase if quality was assured.
