




Rose Balance by Roberto Innocenti and Ian McEwan

Is there always a clear right or wrong?

Rose decides to help by secretly leaving food for the imprisoned people, even though it is very dangerous. Through her courage and kindness, she shows how one person can make a difference, even in a frightening and unfair world.
